Trevor Johnson

**Trevor Johnson** was born in Antioch, CA, the son of missionaries, so his adventures began early. At two years old, Trevor and his family moved to Singapore where his father was interim Asst. Treasurer for the Singapore Conference. After nine months, they moved to the Philippines and remained for eight years. Trevor and his younger sister were homeschooled and learned the traditional tinikling folk dance. After the Philippines, their family spent three years in Guam. Trevor recalls many family vacations touring other countries, totaling over 25 in all. He rode elephants in Sri Lanka and Thailand and even has a souvenir picture frame made from treated, dried elephant dung. In junior high, Trevor's father took a job in the Hawaii Conference as treasurer. The Johnson family thrived in Hawaii. Even though Trevor was afraid of heights, he taught himself to jump off a cliff into a waterfall pool. He also learned bodyboarding, his favorite sport to this day. Trevor was older than the other kids in his class with the transition to the U.S. and was the only Freshman with his driver's license at Hawaiian Mission Academy. One summer, he took a job at Kualoa Ranch, cleaning up after the horses and riding (and drifting) ATV's while tending to the grounds. The Johnson family had an unexpected turn when Trevor's dad, Gary, was diagnosed with Leukemia between Trevor's Freshman and Sophomore year of college. After a valiant battle, Gary went to sleep in Jesus in January of 2016. God opened the door for Trevor's mom to find a teaching job with an SDA school in Georgia, allowing Trevor and his sister to continue the subsidy they were receiving for their Adventist education. After graduating debt free from La Sierra University, God continued His provisions as Trevor was granted a nearly full scholarship to Pepperdine University's School of Law. Trevor is close to completing his first year. He remains thankful for the continual blessings and care of the Lord for himself and his family.
