## Starting New Leadership Meeting

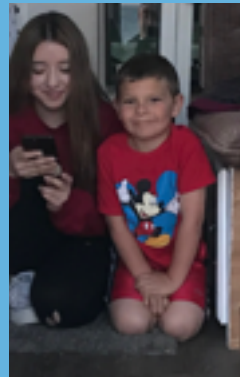
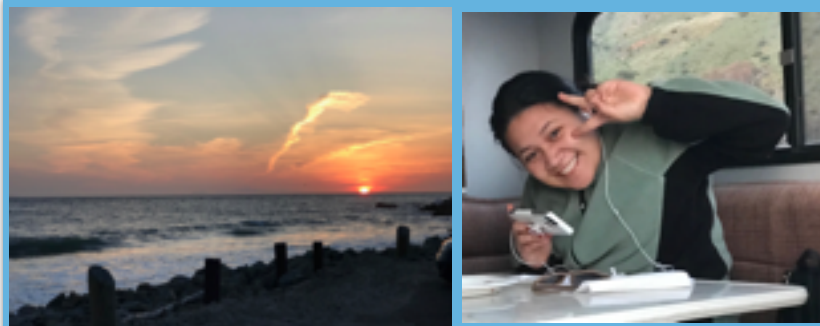
Dear Thousand Oaks Church leaders:

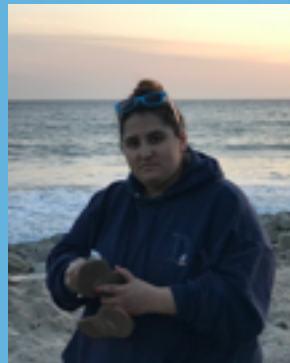
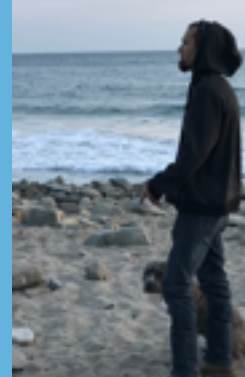

Gerritt Beatty, Jr.

**Gerritt Beatty, Jr.** was born in Charleston, S. Carolina. At age ten, the Beatty's moved to Virginia. Gerritt's early teen years were difficult as he was challenged because of his height. Being short, he struggled with his identity. Gerritt's father introduced him to God and the Bible, even though they were not church attenders. Gerritt, Sr. would tell his son that if he ever had a question, he could pray and then open the Bible and read the passages where the pages fell open. One day at the age of 14, Gerritt was in darkness and tried to follow his father's advice. Opening to random places in the Bible did not give him the answers he was seeking and he became frustrated enough to hurl the Bible across the room. As the Bible laid in a heap, he heard a voice tell him, "Instead of throwing the Bible, why not read it?" So he picked it up. He began in Genesis and continued to read the Bible, cover to cover. To this day, Gerritt maintains that it was the best decision he ever made because it drew him on a new path. In high school, he made many great friends and played on the golf team. He decided that he wanted to find a Christian college. At Pepperdine University, he became president of his fraternity and majored in Business, intending to pursue a career in Architecture. He discovered that he did not like the detail work and stuck with the Business side. In 1996, he was working for a company, supporting their telecom operation. The supervisor in Customer Service was a good looking brunette named Amber who captured his attention. He was glad when she asked him out. He liked that she was also seeking her own relationship with God. Together, they attended many different denominational churches. One day as he was flipping channels on TV, he saw Mark Finley who discussed the Sabbath. Gerritt knew from his own Bible reading that the Sabbath was meant to be set apart. He and Amber found the local Seventh-day Adventist Church in Thousand Oaks to learn more. The first Sabbath they were there, a woman named Mrs. Thompson came running to introduce herself as they were making their way out. She was so welcoming that they kept coming back. It was here that they were both baptized in 2001.
