This weekend is the commemoration of the Baptism of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. It is also the Jewish festival of Shavuot, which commemorates the giving of the Law at Mount Sinai where the Lord organized the newly freed slaves into an organized, cohesive nation within which God would dwell. It was at Shavuot/Pentecost where Christ first organized His Body on earth, the new Temple wherein dwells the Spirit of God. As we hear the story of Jesus, faith awakens, and we are sealed with the promised Holy Spirit. "You also, when you heard the word of truth, the Gospel of your salvation, and believed in Him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of His glory."
