Answer to last week's GUESS WHO....

Laura Coon

Laura Coon grew up in Granada Hills and is a fourth generation Seventh-day Adventist (SDA). Her father was a very hard worker who at one time held three jobs. Her mother was a stay-at-home mom who was extremely active in her kids' lives at school and the Northridge SDA Church. For years, her mom assisted with Vacation Bible School programs and the Pathfinder Club, which Laura began being a participant and was later recruited as a young leader. Laura's father grew up in the country and loved being in nature. Laura remembers their family outdoor activities—biking, hiking, camping, etc. The camping that she remembers was the very primitive type of camping, not the luxurious motorhome camping experience that she enjoys today. Laura grew up attending San Fernando Valley Academy (SFVA), and in fact, it was at her SFVA volleyball game that she met a handsome young visiting guest named Marty. Laura and Marty dated through high school until they were married and moved to the Thousand Oaks area. Laura maintained her attendance at the Northridge Church until one day, an SDA woman named Lilian Guile knocked on her door selling Christian literature. The woman was surprised that Laura commuted to the valley each week and suggested that Laura attend church with her, inviting Laura to the Thousand Oaks SDA Church that was local. Laura and her husband became members in the early 1990's. Even though Laura grew up Christian, it was through her father's death that she truly experienced how real God was for her. She could see how God put things in place far ahead in order to care for their needs in the future, even though those things did not make sense at the time. God's provisions were so profoundly seen that Laura is certain that He exists. Over the years, she has seen the way that God has intervened to protect and care for her and each member of her family. Laura is passionate about ministering to the children and youth and wants them to have the active Christian experience that she has grown up with. Committed to making a difference, Laura continues to remain active in Pathfinders and Adventurers and she has spearheaded a breakfast club ministry here at the TOSDA Church, which she and her husband generously sponsor with time and resources.
