Dear Friends,

I have heard the great news of your efforts to put judgment, strife, and conflict behind you through a service of recommitment to serving Christ in the context of Christian Community. Since John 13:35 minces no words – we'll be known as followers of Jesus by the way(s) we love one another – I can't think of anything more important than working corporately to move forward in this. I pray the you'll be able to keep focus on what matters most – and not those things Romans 14:1 notes simply as "disputable matters."
