Pastor's Corner



The Faithful and Wise Servant

Matthew 24:43-47

But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into. Therefore you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect. Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom his master has set over his household, to give them their food at the proper time? Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions.

When considering the time that God has chosen to come again, I wonder if there are those who would think that they are somehow responsible for the delay, who, by striving to make behavioral changes in themselves or those around them, assure themselves of the Master's acceptance, as if to say that my being ready for the return causes God to return. The idea that we somehow participate in God's timing for the return of Jesus causes us to place emotional baggage on ourselves and those around us. Rather, if we were to just simply value being a servant in the Master's household, paying attention to the needs of others around us, we would bask in the blessing of God's love, mercy and grace. Then, we would be experiencing security against the enemy who works to disrupt our safety in Jesus. The food we share, not only physical but also spiritual, would nourish those who belong to Jesus, and we would be living in the emotional stability of blessedness. This is the life found in the household of God. Let us all be His faithful and wise servants.
