## PLANT-BASED NUTRITION LUNCHEON SEMINAR BRINGS MANY VISITORS

On Sabbath, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 75 people attended the Plant-Based Nutrition Luncheon and Seminar presented by Dr. John Westerdahl and the TO Church Health & Wellness TEAM. About 15 of those attending the program were SDA church members, with 60 visitors from our community. The visitors came from other religious traditions (including Jewish, Hindu, Buddhist, Catholic and other Christian denominations), along with many atheist and agnostics attending. They all came to experience, first-hand, a healthy plant-based meal, and learn about the health benefits of a plant-based diet and lifestyle. Each participant received a free comprehensive Plant-Based Nutrition Quick Start Guidebook, giving them all the scientific information and practical guidance on how to follow a healthier dietary lifestyle. Participants gave the program high ratings on the evaluation forms, expressing their gratitude for this program, with several asking for more nutrition, health & wellness classes, as well as some requests for spiritual wellness, prayer/meditation, and Bible lessons. The TO Health & Wellness TEAM and the Evangelism Committee members will be following up with these interests from our community visitors.

In commenting on the importance of health ministry and evangelism, Ellen G. White states, "The gospel of health is to be firmly linked with the ministry of the Word. It is the Lord's design that the restoring influence of health reform shall be a part of the last great efforts to proclaim the gospel message." Medical Ministry, p. 259
