

### A New Years Resolution Thought

"Not that I have already obtained this or am already completed, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus." -Philippians 3:12-14

As we enter the new year, I can't help but think about all those New Year resolutions that are so common around this time, with all the commercials for getting back in shape or quitting some bad habit. It causes me to think about the success rate of keeping whatever resolution you might have made for yourself. According to <a href="mailto:psychologytoday.com">psychologytoday.com</a> about 80% of resolutions fail by February. So what is the difference between the 80% who don't follow through and the 20% who succeed? I believe it has to do with identity. Do I identify with how I see myself or do I identify with how God sees me?

- 1. **Recognizing that I'm still incomplete**. Jesus is working in me to make me into who He intends me to be. I'm not there yet.
- 2. **Jesus has made me His own.** I continue to discover the value that I fully belong to Jesus. He has claimed me and I am His.
- 3. Forget what lies behind, strain for what lies ahead. Those things that take away from the goals Jesus has for me, do not define who I am in Christ. Like the outside layers of an onion, they are tossed away and forgotten and only the useful parts are chosen to prepare the meal. Those things that are not becoming of Christ peel off my character, as He is working to make me into something useful for others.
- 4. **Press on to the upward call of Christ.** This takes listening. I need to listen to that inward wooing of the Spirit when the Spirit calls me upward. The more attentively I listen to Christ, the more I move toward becoming complete in Christ, where He becomes greater in my life and I become lesser. (See John 3:30) I am not complete yet, but I still belong to Jesus so I forget about my mistakes and look to how Jesus sees me, listening to the Spirit directing me to the upper calling. This is what gives me my new identity in Christ Jesus. I don't resolute to stop or start doing things, rather, I live out Christ in me, the Hope of glory.
